# **CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**

### What is EUSpec?

The goal of the COST action *EUSpec* is to gather activities in theoretical spectroscopy to offer high level support for complex spectroscopy experiments within academic, applied, and industrial research.

#### Who can apply?

Researchers from countries participating in the COST Action EUSpec, approved institutions from Near Neighbor Countries and approved European RTD Organizations can apply for a STSM. Participation of "Early Career Investigators (ECI)" (less than 8 years after the Phd degree) and female applicants is particularly encouraged.

## Purpose of Short Term Scientific Missions

STSMs offer the opportunity to visit other scientists within the COST action to learn a new code, to discuss experimental results with theoreticians and to foster collaborations.

## Where to go?

Researchers can go to an institution or research centre in another participating COST country to foster collaboration and to perform empirical research. The duration of the STSM is between 5 and 90 days.
