

Dear Colleagues,

We are proud to announce **NGSCES 2021: The New Generation in Strongly Correlated Electron Systems, 7-10 June 2021**

After a one-year break due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the conference will return in 2021 and will be held entirely **online**. This year we will introduce online discussion sessions in addition to talks to recreate the interactive conference atmosphere and stimulate the ideas exchange.

The aim of the NGSCES conference is to bring together young researchers in the field of condensed matter physics to review the latest theoretical and experimental developments and to discuss the existing challenges inherent to strongly correlated electron systems.

With the very recent advances in mind, this year we also want to put special emphasis on the use of quantum simulators and quantum annealers to tackle modern problems in condensed matter, on the field of twistrionics in 2D materials and on the oncoming era of free electron lasers to disentangle multi-scale dynamics in a variety of systems.

NGSCES 2021 is organized as an online workshop with keynote, invited and contributed talks. There will be several virtual poster sessions where all the participants can present extensively their work and interact with the other people.

We understand the concerns related to the online format and the hesitation about participation with posters. To address the above we will promote more interactive format with discussion sessions and round table for poster presenters. During the discussion session, selected speakers will present their overview on the specific problem followed by the free discussion with other participants. During the round table, poster presenters will have a limited time slot to give the overview of their work to a wider audience, followed by dedicated discussion in the personal breakout room.

There is no conference fee this year, however the conference will be open to the registered participants only. Thus, we strongly encourage you to register even if you do not plan to make contribution.
