## You will need:

- A statement of purpose explaining your motivations and expectations of grad school as well as why you believe our program will help you achieve your goals.
- Transcripts (copies of official transcripts are accepted)
- · 3 letters of recommendation, to be submitted online by the recommender
- · An updated CV
- For students graduating from a university where English is not the medium of instruction, a TOEFL (>90) or IELTS (>6.5) score is required. Note however, that the GRE is no longer required.

Ph.D students are offered financial support (\$34,000/year) and a tuition remission. The assistantship and tuition remission are renewable for up to 5 years for Ph.D. students in good academic standing and who meet all other terms of the assistantship agreement.
